

DIGITAL WORKSHOP AND PRESENTATIONS 2020 September 19 – 22, 2020

CALL FOR PAPERS

As Monorail-Systems today are understood as an effective alternative in public transportation, there is an increasing interest worldwide in the development of monorail systems, as demonstrated by the construction of large systems in China, Brazil, Thailand, Egypt. The movement is creating an opportunity to assess the best practices developed to date to assist Operators and the Public on assessing the applicability of monorail systems.

We cordially invite you to join and participate in the IMA Digital Workshop and Presentations 2020. The virtual meeting will be organized in a series of activities in 4 days, Saturday, September 19 to Tuesday, September 22, in three-hour sessions each day. Presentations will be held on Sunday, 20th September and Monday, 21st September, and each presenter will be given fifteen (15) minutes to present their topics. The length of the sessions will allow people in the Americas Pacific Coast (UTC-7 hours), and people in the far east, UTC +8 hours) can attend.

Publication and Paper Review:

The workshop papers and presentations will be published in an electronic reader. The papers should never have been published before in academic journals or conferences and should be of academic and practical value.

Review Process: Abstracts will be accepted and sent to peer review by specialists. The review period of papers is 15 days.

Paper Submission Due: Friday, August 7, 2020.

Acceptance / Rejection Notice: 15 days after the paper submission.
